#### PART I

### IS YESHUA / JESUS THE MESSIAH?

#### The Word of God was written so that we can know what the truth is.

Through his holy prophets, God chronicled in the Bible numerous prophecies that have been accurately fulfilled and that will be fulfilled. There is no other book like the Bible in the world.

Starting on the 4th page is a tabular list of some of the numerous prophecies that Yeshua fulfilled with his first coming 2000 years ago, with references to other sources presenting more of the prophecies that he fulfilled. No other person, before or since, has fulfilled such a multitude of prophecies so accurately as Yeshua.

Because of his great love for us, Yeshua was sent from God the Father in the form of man in order to be presented as a sacrifice to atone once and for all man's sin: past, present, and future. The shedding of Yeshua's blood at the cross made a way for the reconciliation of man's relationship back to God; permitting a deep loving partnership in life, and in eternity, between God and his people similar to the marriage of a man and woman.

Yeshua's first coming was foretold in Micah 5:2 and the details of Yeshua's sacrifice when he was nailed to the cross were prophesied in Isaiah 53 and Psalm 22. When he died, his journey through "the valley of the shadow of death" was prophesied in Psalm 23. His glorious resurrection back from death was prophesied in Psalm 24. The tabular list goes into more detail with additional scriptures that were fulfilled by Yeshua.

Essentially, the name Yeshua means "God saves". There are similar forms of Yeshua in the Bible, such as Jeshua ( ש ו ש י) "Jah is help" in Ezra 2:36, and Jehoshua ( ש ו ש י) "Jah saves" in Numbers 13:16. A very significant revelation of Yeshua in the Bible is from Psalm 118:14, as well as several dozen other scriptures in the Old Testament containing the word "salvation":

"The LORD *is* my strength and song, and is become my salvation." Psalm 118:14

The word "salvation" in the verse above in Hebrew ( י ש ו ע ה ) is "yeshuah"! Psalm 118:14 is saying that "The LORD ( י ה )(Yah or Jah)... is become my Yeshua"! Yah or Jah is a contraction of the full name YHWH.

The "full name" of God is הוה (YHVH / Yehovah or YHWH / Yahweh), and it first appears in Genesis 2:4 and is more typically referred to as "LORD" in the KJV English translation:

"These *are* the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens," Genesis 2:4

The name JEHOVAH appears in the KJV English translation in several verses, most notably:

"And God spake unto Moses, and said unto him, I *am* the LORD: And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by *the name of* God Almighty ( ' א ל ש ר' ' El Shaddai"), but by my name JEHOVAH ( ' ה ו ה ) was I not known to them." Exodus 6:2-3

And especially this verse!

"Behold, God (אל') *is* my salvation (אל') (שועה "yeshuah"); I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD (ה' "Yah") JEHOVAH (הוה) *is* my strength and *my* song; he also is become my salvation (אל' "yeshuah")." Isaiah 12:2

Using the Hebrew letter pictograph chart below, God's name הוה ' translates in Hebraic-convention from right to left to mean: "the hand behold, the nail behold" or in English-convention from left to right to mean: "behold the nailed hand"! God's name is revealing Yeshua! Perhaps this is why Rabbis of Orthodox Judaism choose to refer to הוה ' as "HaShem", or "the Name" because they say that הוה ' is "too holy to pronounce". However, maybe the real reason is that the Rabbis do not want people to make the connection of Yeshua being revealed in God's name because that would mean Yeshua must be the Messiah!

One reason put forth by Rabbis of Orthodox Judaism as to why they have issue with Yeshua as the Messiah, is because of the "display of violence" when Yeshua drove the moneychangers out of the temple as presented in Matthew 21 and Mark 11 of the New Testament. They say that if Yeshua was a fulfillment of Isaiah 53 then his behavior was inconsistent with verse 9: "...*because he had done no violence*...", so why did Yeshua do this?

"And Jesus (*Yeshua*) went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves, And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves." Matthew 21:12-13

Yeshua was only doing what the temple priests should have already done, to drive out the abomination (ref. the Deuteronomy verses, next page). To label what he did as "violence" is very subjective. The real question is why were the temple priests tolerating diverse weights & measures to operate in the temple? Yeshua said in Matthew 6:24 "...Ye cannot serve God and mammon." The appearance of hypocrisy and filthy lucre are risks to be avoided.

"Thou shalt not have in thy bag divers weights, a great and a small. Thou shalt not have in thine house divers measures, a great and a small. *But* thou shalt have a perfect and just weight, a perfect and just measure shalt thou have: that thy days may be lengthened in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. For all that do such things, *and* all that do unrighteously, *are* an abomination unto the LORD thy God." Deuteronomy 25:13-16

At the end of the following eleven page listing is a truly remarkable parallel between Moses in Exodus 3 and Yeshua in John 18. The revelation of it is a miracle because it shows that Yeshua is predestined and ordained to be MESSIAH.

#### EXODUS 3:

<sup>1</sup>Now <u>Moses kept the flock</u> of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to <u>the mountain of</u> <u>God</u>, *even* to Horeb.

<sup>2</sup>And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a <u>flame of fire out of the midst of a bush</u>: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush *was* not consumed.

<sup>3</sup>And Moses said, <u>I will now turn aside, and see this</u> great sight, why the bush is not burnt.

<sup>4</sup>And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, <u>God called unto him out of the midst of the bush</u>,

...and said, Moses, Moses.

...And <u>he said, Here am I</u>.

<sup>5</sup>And he said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest *is* holy ground.



#### THE BIBLICAL STORY OF THE 12 CONSTELLATIONS OF THE ZODIAC

The Ecliptic is the path of the sun through its annual tour of the 12 constellations.

The Precession of the Equinoxes is the great precessional cycle, where the sun returns back to the same point at the same time of the year (i.e. Spring Equinox), and it takes 25,800 years. In the constellation COMA, near Virgo, is believed to be the location where the Star of Bethlehem shone forth.

Reference: <u>The Witness of the Stars</u> by E.W. Bullinger and <u>The Heavens Declare</u> by W.D. Banks.

#### NOTES

- 1 "For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be." Matt. 24:27
- 2 The sun rises out of the east and sets in the west. Hebrew is read from right to left. America was settled from east to west. The temple is entered from east to west.
- 3 At the Second Coming, Jesus will touch down on the Mount of Olives and triumphantly walk through the east gate of Jerusalem. Reference Zechariah 14:4 and Ezekiel 44:1-3.
- 4 When the Zodiac was originally "drawn", the North Pole Star was in the constellation DRACO and was called Alpha Draconis (Dragon Star). After the fall of Lucifer, the star Al-Ruccaba (the Gate) in the constellation Ursa Minor (Little Dipper) became Polaris the North Pole Star. Reference <u>The Heavens Declare</u> by W.D. Banks, p. 203-204.
- 5 The Zodiac ecliptic is the path of the sun through the stars of the 12 Zodiac constellations as seen from Earth, roughly at a 70 degree angle to the Milky Way Galaxy.
- 6 The precession is the movement of the sun in and out of alignment with the plane of the galactic equator. This movement is due to the Earth's wobble and it shifts the positions of the vernal / autumnal equinoxes and the two solstices 1/2 degree every 36 years, relative to the galactic equator.
- 7 E.W. Bullinger said the duration of one cycle of the precession is 25,800 years. David Flynn says it is 25,920 years, and divided by 4 = 6,480 years which is the duration of one epoch of civilization, with four total epochs per precession cycle. That is why the Mayan calendar contains four quarters.
- 8 The Milky Way intersects the ecliptic at two points, at Gemini (10) and near Scorpio (3). Near Scorpio is the location of the constellation of the serpent contender, a man stepping on a scorpion and holding a snake / serpent.
- 9 At point (3) on the date 12-21-2012, there is a conjunction of the sun with Scorpio (the scorpion/eagle) and with the center of the galaxy. The center of the Milky Way Galaxy has a bulge at its center called the nuclear bulge and it is representative of the serpent's head. The conjunction of the sun-Scorpio/eagle-serpent's head bulge on the 2012 winter solstice is representative of the end of one cycle and the start of another. The Mayans took this to mean the end of civilization and the beginning of another epoch of civilization. It is symbolized by the Phoenix bird rising out of the ashes or otherwise known by some as "Order Out of Chaos". This takes place once every 25,800 years per E.W. Bullinger.

# PART III: GOD

#### PART III

#### THE NAMES OF GOD

**A** study of God's names presents more insight about the amazing person called "GOD". This was covered in some detail in Chapter 1 and that information is repeated here, but along with additional detail for more understanding about Him. Keep in mind that certain Hebrew letters correspond to more than one English letter; for example the 10<sup>th</sup> letter of the Hebrew alphabet ' corresponds to the letters I, J, or Y and is pronounced "yod or jod", and sometimes jot (as in Matt. 5:18). The same goes for the 6<sup>th</sup> letter of the Hebrew alphabet 1 which corresponds to the letters O, U, V, or W and is pronounced "vau". These two Hebrew letters ' and 1 will show up in God's name ( $\pi$   $\pi$   $\pi$  " "YHVH") and so the English spelling of His name can vary as shown below.

HIS OLD TESTAMENT (OT) NAMES

EL (Hebrew:  $7 \times$  aleph-lamed): God, "Mighty One". Strong's 410.

AL (Hebrew: <sup>ツ</sup> y ayin-lamed): "Most High". Strong's 5920.

**ELOHIM (Hebrew: אל הים אל aleph-lamed-he-yod-mem):** God, "He, plural, who is worshipped". The name most commonly used for God in the OT. The Trinity Godhead, a plural of Eloah. Strong's 430.

ELOAH (Hebrew: לוה א לוה k aleph-lamed-vau-he): God, "He who is worshipped". Strong's 433.

ELAH (Hebrew: っ う な aleph-lamed-he): God, god, or gods "an object of worship". Strong's 426.

YHVH –"YEHOVAH or YAHWEH or sometimes YAHUAH" (Hebrew: הוה ' yod-he-vau-he): LORD (all CAPs), "He who is". First appears in Genesis 2:4 as "LORD" in the KJV English translation. The name of God known directly to Moses (Exodus 6:3). The formal OT name for Jesus. Its four Hebrew letters literally translate to "hand-behold-nail-behold". The most common form for LORD in the OT. Strong's 3068.

**YAH or JAH (Hebrew:** 7 ' **yod-he):** "LORD", a contraction of YHVH. Strong's 3050.

YEHOVIH (Hebrew: הוה ' yod-he-vau-he): GOD (all CAPs). Strong's 3069.

TSUR (Hebrew: T 1 3 tzadi-vau-resh): God, "a rock". Strong's 6697. Verse Isaiah 44:8.

ADON (Hebrew: 17% aleph-dalet-vau-nun): "Lord", "sir", or "master". When in lower case (lord) then it is in reference to a person (sir or master) and when in upper case then in reference to God (Lord). Strong's 113.

ADONAI (Hebrew: 'こて & aleph-dalet-nun-yod): "Lord", "my lords". Typically only in reference to GOD. Context is a holy Boss or King. Strong's 136.

MARE (Hebrew: X ¬ Ď mem-resh-aleph): lord, Lord, "master". Strong's 4756. Verse Daniel 5:23.

EL SHADDAI (Hebrew: ' び う ざ aleph-lamed-shin-dalet-yod): "God Almighty", "all sufficient". The name of God known to Moses' forefathers. Verse: Exodus 6:3. Strong's 410.

IAM THAT I AM or I AM (Hebrew: ボ ちょう た お つ び な お お aleph-he-yod-he aleph-shin-resh aleph-he-yod-he): "unsearchableness of God", "strength-behold-hand-behold" or "strong hand of the Lord". Reference verse is Exodus 3:14, and is the only time this name appears in the OT.

YEHOVAH-YIREH or "*Jehovah-Jireh*" (Hebrew: הוה יראה yod-he-vau-he yod-resh-aleph-he): "Jehovah will see to it" or "the Lord will provide". Symbolic name for Mount Moriah. Strong's 3070. Verse: Genesis 22:14.

YEHOVAH-RAPHAH or "*Jehovah-Raphah*" (Hebrew: הוה רפה 'yod-he-vau-he resh-peh-he): "the Lord who heals". Symbolic name for Mount Moriah. Strong's 3068 plus 7495. Verse: Exodus 15:26.

#### THE NAMES OF GOD

YEHOVAH-NICCIY or "*Jehovah-Nissi*" (Hebrew: הוה נס' yod-he-vau-he nun-samech-yod): "Jehovah my banner". Symbolic name of an altar in the Desert. Strong's 3071. Verse: Exodus 17:15.

YEHOVAH-TSIDQENUW or "*Jehovah-Tsidkenu*" (Hebrew: הוה צרקנו 'yod-he-vau-he tzadi-dalet-kof-nun-vau): "Jehovah our righteousness". Symbolic epithet of Messiah & Jerusalem. Strong's 3072. Verse: Jeremiah 33:16.

YEHOVAH-SHALOWM or "*Jehovah-Shalom*" (Hebrew: הוה שלום 'yod-he-vau-he shin-lamed-vau-mem): "Jehovah is peace". Symbolic name of an altar in Palestine. Strong's 3073. Verse: Judges 6:24

YEHOVAH-SHAMMAH or "*Jehovah-Shammah*" (Hebrew: הוה ש מה 'yod-he-vau-he shin-mem-he): "Jehovah is thither (there)". Symbolic title of Jerusalem. Strong's 3074. Verse: Ezekiel 48:35.

YEHOVAH-QADASH or "*Jehovah-Kadash*" (Hebrew: קרה קרה ישטי) yod-he-vau-he kof-dalet-shin): "the LORD who sanctifies". Strong's 3068 plus 6942. Sometimes spelled *Jehovah-M'Kadash*. Verse: Leviticus 20:8.

YEHOVAH-RA'AH or "*Jehovah-Raw-aw*" (Hebrew: יהוה רעה yod-he-vau-he resh-ayin-he): "the LORD our Shepherd". Strong's 3068 plus 7462. Sometimes spelled *Jehovah-Rohi.* Verse: Psalm 23:1.

YEHOVAH-TSABA or "*Jehovah-Tsaw-baw*" (Hebrew: ג ב א yod-he-vau-he tzadi-bet-aleph): "the LORD of hosts". Strong's 3068 plus 6635. Verse: Jeremiah 32:18, Psalm 24:10.

EL ELYON (Hebrew: ל עליון אל מופh-lamed ayin-lamed-yod-vau-nun): "God, most high". Strong's 410 plus 5946. Verse: Genesis 14:22.

EL OLAM (Hebrew: גל מ אל אל aleph-lamed ayin-lamed-mem): "God, everlasting". Strong's 410 plus 5769. Verse: Genesis 21:33.

EL GIBBOR (Hebrew: אל גבר אit aleph-lamed gimel-bet-resh): "God, mighty". Strong's 410 plus 1360. Verse: Jeremiah 32:18.

EL RA'AH (Hebrew: אל האה איל א aleph-lamed resh-aleph-he): "God, who sees". Strong's 410 plus 7200. Sometimes spelled *El Roi*. Verse: Genesis 16:13.

Beer-lahai-roi, name of a well: "well of a living (One) my seer". Strong's 883: Be'er la-Chay Ro'iy (אר ר ל הי bet-aleph-resh lamed-chet-vod resh-aleph-vod). Verse: Genesis 16:14.

And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God (*Elohim*)."

**KURIOS (Greek:**  $K \upsilon \rho \iota o \varsigma$  **Kappa-upsilon-rho-iota-omicron-stigma):** God, "Lord, master". Verse: Acts 19:20.

**KURIOS (Greek:**  $K \upsilon \rho \iota o \varsigma$  **Kappa-upsilon-rho-iota-omicron-stigma):** Lord, "Lord, sir, master". The most common form for Lord in the NT. Verse: Matthew 22:37 (Theos).

**DESPOTES (Greek:**  $\Delta \epsilon \sigma \pi o \tau \eta \varsigma$  **Delta-epsilon-sigma-pi-omicron-tau-eta-stigma):** Lord, "a despot (absolute ruler), master". Verse: Revelation 6:10.

**RABBONI (Greek:**  $P \alpha \beta \beta o \nu \iota$  **Rho-alpha-beta-beta-omicron-nu-iota):** Lord, "my master, my rabbi". Verse: Mark 10:51.

**THEOMACHEO (Greek:**  $\Theta \varepsilon \circ \mu \alpha \chi \varepsilon \omega$  **Theta-epsilon-omicron-mu-alpha-chi-epsilon-omega):** To fight against God. Verse: Acts 23:9.

#### THEODIDAKTOS (Greek: Θεοδιδακτος

Theta-epsilon-omicron-delta-iota-delta-alpha-kappa-tau-omicron-stigma): Taught of God. Verse: 1 Thessalonians 4:9.

#### THEOPNEUSTOS (Greek: Θεοπνευστος

**Theta-epsilon-omicron-pi-nu-epsilon-upsilon-sigma-tau-omicron-stigma):** Given by inspiration of God, "God breathed". Verse: 2 Timothy 3:16.

**THEOSEBES (Greek:**  $\Theta \epsilon o \sigma \epsilon \beta \eta \varsigma$  **Theta-epsilon-omicron-sigma-epsilon-beta-eta-stigma):** Worshipper of God, "one who fears or reverences God". Verse: John 9:31.

**CHREMATIZO (Greek:**  $X \rho \eta \mu \alpha \tau \iota \zeta \omega$  **Chi-rho-eta-mu-alpha-tau-iota-zeta-omega):** Admonished of God, "to warn by an oracle". Verse: Hebrews 8:5.

#### CHREMATISMOS (Greek: Χρηματισμος

**Chi-rho-eta-mu-alpha-tau-iota-sigma-mu-omicron-stigma):** Answered of God, "oracular warning". Verse: Romans 11:4.

**THEOSTUGES (Greek:**  $\Theta \epsilon o \sigma \tau \upsilon \gamma \eta \varsigma$  **Theta-epsilon-omicron-sigma-tau-upsilon-gamma-eta-stigma):** Hater of God. Verse: Romans 1:30.

**PHILOTHEOS (Greek:**  $\Phi \iota \lambda o \theta \epsilon o \varsigma$  Theta-epsilon-omicron-sigma-tau-upsilon-gamma-eta-stigma): Lover of God. Verse: 2 Timothy 3:4.

**THEIOS (Greek:**  $\Theta \epsilon \iota o \varsigma$  **Theta-epsilon-iota-omicron-stigma):** The Godhead, "that which is divine". Verse: Acts 17:29.

**THEIOTES (Greek:**  $\Theta \epsilon \iota o \tau \eta \varsigma$  Theta-epsilon-iota-omicron-tau-eta-stigma): Godhead, "divinity". Verse: Romans 1:20.

**THEOTES (Greek:**  $\Theta \epsilon o \tau \eta \varsigma$  **Theta-epsilon-omicron-tau-eta-stigma):** Godhead, "deity". Verse: Colossians 2:9.
